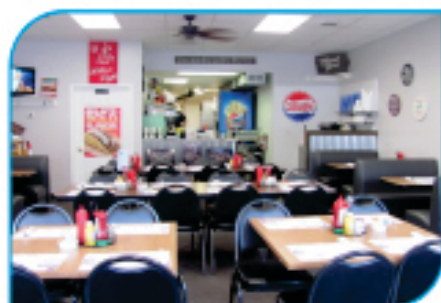
### **CAFETERIA**

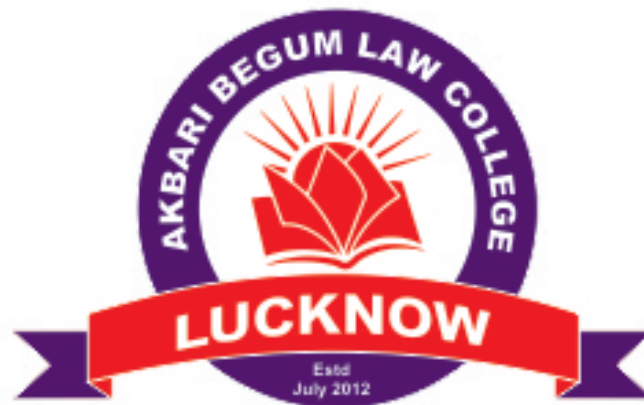
### **TRANSPORT**

## Rules & Regulation

### • Discipline-

All the students of AKBARI BEGUM LAW COLLEGE should maintain the glory of the institution. ### • Disciplinary Committee-

To maintain discipline in the institute, the disciplinary Committee has been constituted. The Principal, proctor and professors are the members of this committee, who keep an eye on the activities of the students. So students must not involve in any such activity which will break the discipline of the institute and the committee is compelled to take action against students.

### • Dress Code-

Students will have to come to the college in prescribed uniform.

Boys - White Shirt, Black trouser and Black Tie

### • Vehicle Stand-

- 6- Every student is urged to contribute to the Value and Standards of the institute by his/her conduct, discipline and behavior.
- 7-It is presumed that at the time of submission of the admission form, all the rules, regulation and conditions are read and accepted by the students and his/her parents/guardians



## Admission Procedure

### IMP: Brochure & Application form are available in College Office Only.

- The prospectus and the application form for admission can be obtained from the college on payment of Rs. 1000/- .
- The application form duly filled should be submitted in the office within the prescribed period along with the 3 set self attested copies of following documents:-
  - a. High school mark sheet and high school certificate.
  - b. Intermediate mark sheet and transfer certificate in original for B.A.LL.B. 5 yrs. (Hons) Course
  - c. Graduation mark sheet and Transfer/Migration Certificate for LL.B. 3 yrs.
  - d. Character certificate from the institute last attended.
  - e. Caste, income, domicile Certificate and Aadhar Card in the case of S.C/S.T/O.B.C/Minority candidates for purpose of granting scholarship etc.
- Admission to the courses will be based on merit and interviews.
- No age limit for Admission in LL.B. 3 years or LL.B (Hons) candidates belonging to any category .
- Admissions are at the sole discretion of the Management Committee of the college; which are to be confirmed further by the Principal and admission Committee.
- All admission are provisional and are subject to confirmation by eligibility criteria laid down by the University of Lucknow.
- All students seeking admission shall apply only in the prescribed form issued along with the brochure.
- Incomplete forms will not be considered & fees has to be paid at time of admission as decided by the college or else admission may be cancelled.
- The full fees in DD/Cheque/online payment methods as described in the fee structure will have to be paid at the time of admission. Fees shall be paid before 5.00 p.m. during the days of admission.
- To get admission in LL.B. (Three Years) a candidate must have passed 10+2+3 examination from any recognized Board/University of India with minimum 45% marks for General/OBC & 40% SC/ST candidates.
- Candidate of other states need to submit character/Domicile certificate from concern authorities.
- After getting admission a candidate must secure 66% of class attendance as per regulation of Bar Council of India & Lucknow University.
- Law college has following rights to
  - a- Admission may be cancelled by giving any reason.
  - b- To amend rules & regulation of admission of college.
  - C- Decision of Principal is final for admission.
  - d- Candidates serving in public/private sector must submit N.O.C. from their respective departments.

# LL.B. (HONOURS) 5 YEARS INTERGRATED PROGRAMME

It is a combination of B.A. and LL.B. Course. Its Purpose is to educate and train candidates for taking up legal profession and pursue other avenues wherein Law Subject are either compulsory or optional.

The entire course is spread over 10 Semesters. Each of six months, generally starting on 1st July. It has been divided into two parts as follows:

Part-I - 2 Year core Programme of pre-law studies and

Part-II - 3 Year Programme for professional training in law.

## ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

This course is open to those who have passed intermediate or equivalent (10+2 or 11+1) examination from any recognized Board with minimum given % of marks as decided by the University and Bar Council of India from time to time. Candidates shall be admitted on the basis of merit which shall be judged by their performance in the qualifying examination and also the result of test and interview held by the admission committee of the college. Preference will be given to those who can express themselves in English.

Rule 6 (1) of Part IV of the Bar Council Rules lays down the following "The Part-I Examination should be so conducted as to be called University Examination. A student who has passed Part-I of the law course shall be eligible for enrolment in the final year of the three years degree course in Arts, Social Science etc. supplicate for the B.A. degree. A student who has completed three years of the 5 years course in Law is eligible to get a degree from the University on passing such examination on conducted by the same University which is equivalent to B.A. (Law) but such degree shall not entitle the student to be enrolled as an Advocate. That enrolment will be possible after completing remaining two years course, which includes practical training also"

### NOTE :

The candidates who are appearing for the qualifying examination and expect to complete the eligibility requirements can also appear at the entrance test but their candidature will be considered only when they provide documentary evidence of eligibility requirement.

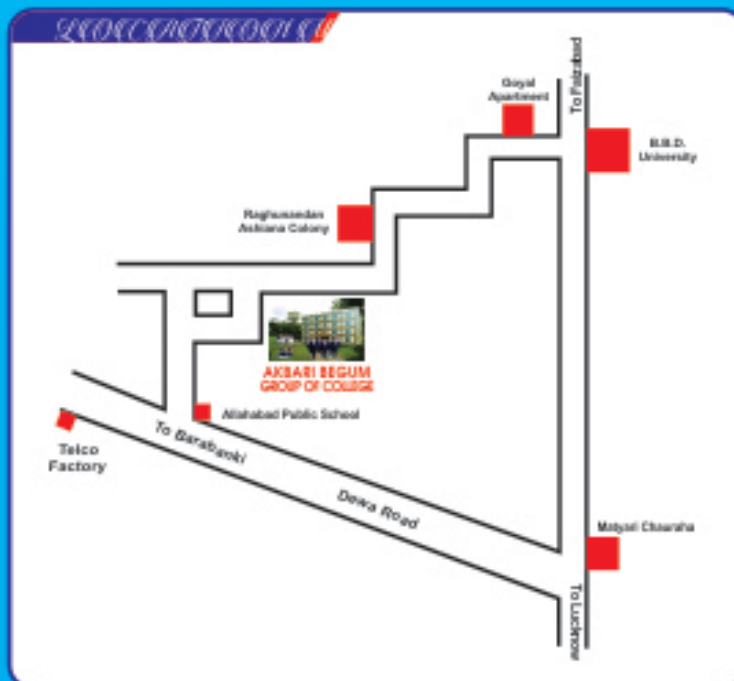
